

By-law 6: Visitors

1. The Sutherland Bushwalking Club encourages visitors to participate in club activities. Visitors may participate in up to three one-day activities in any one financial year, without becoming a member.
2. Visitors who wish to participate in extended activities lasting more than one day, are required to join the club before participation.
3. Visitors arise via several ways:
 - a. Friends or relatives of members, who may be visiting Sydney;
 - b. Those who have become aware of the Club, and would like to try out some activities to see if they like it;
 - c. Visitors from interstate or overseas who would like to participate in some activities for a short time.
4. Visitors must contact the Activity Organiser to obtain agreement to participate in the activity. Visitors, who do not know any members, can send an email to info@sutherlandbushwalkers.org.au or follow the contact instructions included in our website.
5. The same procedures will apply to any visitor as with Club members. The Activity Organiser will, after discussion with the visitor, determine if the visitor can participate. The Activity Organiser will take into consideration whether the activity is suitable for their level of fitness and if they have clothing and equipment suitable for participation in the activity.
6. A visitor will be required to sign the Risk Waiver form before participating in an activity.
